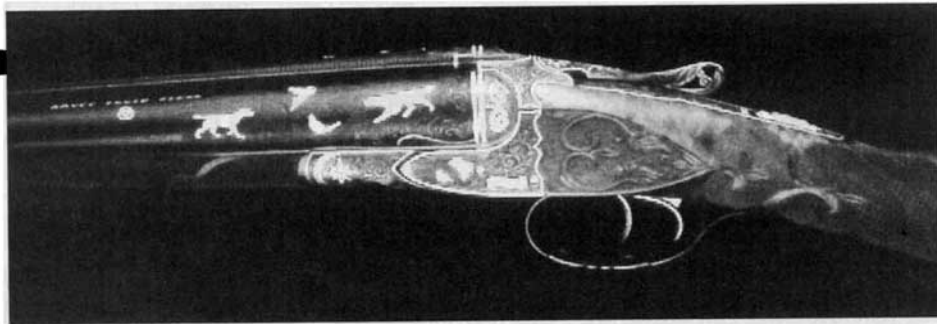

New A.H. Fox 16, 28 and .410 Guns

The Connecticut Shotgun Manufacturing Company of New Britain, Connecticut, is building the A.H. Fox double-barrel shotgun in three additional gauges: 16, 28 and .410. Since mid-1994, they have been shipping hand-finished, U.S.-manufactured, 20-gauge side-by-sides in five grades. The three new gauges will also be available in five grades and will be built utilizing the same manufacturing process that won the prestigious "Shotgun of the Year" award for their 20-gauge gun in 1994. This award, recognizing excellence in product design, quality and service to the industry, is presented annually by the Shooting Industry Academy Of Excellence. According to Dick Perrett, President of the Connecticut Shotgun Manufacturing Company, response to the reintroduction of the 20-gauge A.H. Fox has been very successful; however, many hunters, shooters and collectors expressed a desire for 16, 28 and .410-gauge guns, as well as multi-gauge barrel sets. As Dick Perrett explains, "Our 28 and .410-gauge guns are priced slightly higher than their counterparts in 16 and 20 gauge because of necessary modifications to the action for the smaller-gauge guns." New A.H. Fox guns are priced from \$7,200 for the CE grade (\$8,200 for 28 and .410 gauge) to \$17,500 for the top of the standard-line FE grade (\$19,700 for 28 and .410 gauge). Most of the A.H. Fox double guns are made to order. The customer specifies grade, stock and forend style, butt type, barrel length and chokes, etc. At the present time, they are quoting delivery dates of 12 months for 16, 28 and .410-gauge guns and multi-gauge barrel sets.
